

NATURAL ENVIRO 8000 BIOREMEDIATION

Natural Enviro 8000 is a highly concentrated microbial formulation (50 billion CFU/ gram), which consists of a proprietary blend of beneficial aerobic bacteria. It is available in two formulations. Our Petroleum Waste Degrading formula has been proven for over a decade to eliminate crude oil and its 300,000 derivatives. Our Chlorinated Solvent degrading formulation is effective on trichloroethylene (TCE), perchloroethylene (PCE), trichloroethane (TCA), polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), complex polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons, trinitrotoluene (TNT), DDT and dioxin, to name a few.

Natural Enviro 8000 should be applied within 1 hour of mixing into solution. Apply the solution directly to the contaminated soil or water. Nutrients and/ or biological growth catalysts may be needed to enhance the bioremediation process.

Available in 25 lb pails and 300 lb drums.

APPLICATION

Contaminated Soil:

Use 8 oz of Natural Enviro 8000 per cubic yard of contaminated soil. Mix with water prior to application. Use as much water as is required to achieve at least 10% moisture content in the soil.

Surface Sheen on Soil:

Per cubic yard of contaminated soil: Mix .5 lbs of Natural Enviro 8000 with 1-2 gallons of tap water. Immediately spray-apply the solution. Till into the top 2-4 inches of soil. For month 1 and month 2 apply every 2 weeks. Then apply monthly thereafter.

Contaminated Water:

Add 8 oz of Natural Enviro 8000 per 200 gallons of contaminated water. Add powder directly to contaminated water.

Surface Sheen on Water:

Per 1000 square feet of surface area: Mix 2 lbs of Natural Enviro 8000 with 5 gallons of tap water. Immediately spray-apply the solution, covering the entire surface area. For month 1 and month 2 apply every 2 weeks. Then apply monthly thereafter.
